Nursery to Reception - Children born between 1 September 2015 and 31 August 2016 are due to start school in September 2020. Safeguarding Assembly - On Thursday, Miss Yates discussed safeguarding again with the children in assembly. The children were asked to think about all the ways the school tries to keep children safe. Very quickly, the children came up with lots of examples, including:

- Supervising children in school and in the playground, including the school whistle system.
- School rules, which help to keep us safe.
- Helping children to stay safe in the heat.
- Helping children to stay safe on the internet and the use of mobile phones.
- Making sure children know what they do if they think they or someone is being bullied.
- Stranger danger.
- Fire drills.
- What to do or who to go to in school? If the children have any worries, problems or if they are generally unhappy.
