After School Arrangements - We have always welcomed parents and children to use our school playground out of school hours and would like to continue to do so. However, we have received a number of queries regarding children staying on school grounds out of school hours and we would like to clarify the matter.

At the end of the school day, children **must not** stay on the school grounds unless they are met by an adult or arrangements are made with other parents that they will take responsibility for the child i.e. either an adult meets them from school or children go home first before returning to play on the field. Children **cannot** just remain at school without a clear place of safety to go. The school is not responsible for children when school is finished and it would be unsafe for children to be left at school without a place to go should it rain or if an accident should occur. We cannot guarantee that staff will be on the school site once school/clubs are finished.
