**After School Arrangements** - The current after school arrangements will stay in place at present and will be discussed at the next Governors meeting. The arrangements are as follows:

At the end of the school day, children **must not** stay on the school grounds unless they are met by an adult or arrangements are made with other parents that they will take responsibility for the child i.e. either an adult meets them from school or children go home first before returning to play on the field. Children **cannot** just remain at school without a clear place of safety to go. The school is responsible for children 10 minutes before school and up to 10 minutes after (3:30pm). Any time outwith this, the responsibility belongs to parents/guardians.
