Term Time Absence - School has a duty to monitor the attendance of every pupil in school, and to provide the necessary support and intervention to ensure this is maintained. This year, we have had a large number of requests for holidays in term time which will seriously impact on pupils' attendance data. Please can we remind parents that these cannot be authorised and that work rotas or cost of holidays are not regarded as sufficient reason to take holidays in term time. We ask that family holidays for the coming academic year are taken during school holidays and not booked for term time.

In addition, in Sept 2015, the persistent absence threshold for pupils was lowered to 10% and Ofsted now use this threshold in its inspection regime. This means that any pupil will be classed as 'persistently absent' when they have missed 38 or more sessions (19 days) at any point during the academic year. When attendance drops below this threshold it may trigger more formal intervention such as a referral to County.

Midday Supervisor - We have a vacancy for a midday supervisor to cover maternity leave. The hours will be Mondays, 12pm-1pm. Please contact the school office if you would be interested in this position.

Chill Factor Reminder, Y6 - Please remember to bring your own packed lunch and meet at JRS at 8:30am.

Privacy Notice - You will be aware that a new regulation regarding Data Protection came into force in May 2018. The 'General Data Protection Regulation' (GDPR) outlines how we can use your personal data and how we keep it safe. GDPR is also designed to strengthen the rights you have regarding your data. Although this will have a relatively small impact on parents and the day-to-day running of school, we are required to update our privacy notices to comply with this new legislation. These will be sent out to parents early next week and also placed on our school website.
